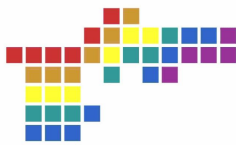

We are thrilled to announce our collaboration with Para Los Niños (PLN). PLN is a multifaceted nonprofit social service organization that supports over 6,000 children, youth, and families throughout Los Angeles County.

TMCC's partnership with PLN will be our first in our efforts to serve adults who do not have access to counseling services.

Child and Family Program Expansion



The Child and Family Program's Community Intervention Program now partners with four agencies: the Alexandria House preschool, the Girl's Club of Los Angeles' Faith Children's Center, the Westside Jewish Community Center's Early Childhood Program and St. Sebastian School.

Therapeutic and child developmental services are available at each site as well as individual and group counseling, support for the teaching and administrative staff, and assistance with referrals for additional specialized help at other agencies when needed.

Services are provided through TMCC's Child and Family Program.
